The Secretary's report for September was accepted as read.

The Treasurer reported on the checkbook balance. A motion was made and carried to file for future audit.

The Financial Secretary turned in money from memberships consisting of 3 new members and 1 spousal membership equaling 4 members with the purchase of 3 indoor range cards. There are 380 members as of October 6, 2008. A motion was made and carried to file for future audit.

COMMITTEE REPORT:

Claybird – Turned in money for targets and ammo. Shooting on Wednesday night continues. Money was turned in from the Winter Skeet League, which began October 5<sup>th</sup>. The Winter League has expanded to 24 shooters from 20 last year. The interclub trap competition was held at Cumberland Beagle Oct. 4<sup>th</sup>. Cumberland won but all had a good time.

Pistol –The last 2700 Competition was held September 28. Due to rain, there were only three shooters. Money was turned in. The dates for the two day Regional Competition have been approved by the NRA, which will be held on June 6 and 7 of 2009. The hour meter has been put on the indoor range burner to track run time. T8 lights have been purchased and more are needed.

Rifle – Rocks and boulders have been removed from the cave shooting area. The rifle shoot dates have been submitted to the web.

Budget – The budget committee recommends that the range card fee be increased by \$10.00 and the Clay bird member shooting fee be increased to \$3.00.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Bill L spoke to Chris who will do the burner cleaning and maintain them during the winter.
2. The club newsletter was submitted and will be sent out with the membership renewals.
3. A letter was sent to Bob D thanking him for attending the September Board Meeting and advising him of the restoration of his Range Officer duties.
4. The South Shore League dues have been paid.
5. The Pistol Range chimney still needs to be checked.
6. The snow blower has been started.

2. A motion was made and carried to increase the Range Card fee by \$10.00 and the Clay bird member shooting fee to \$3.00.

4. A motion was made and carried to spend money for the purchase of 13 pallets of clay targets.
5. The use of 2 movable targets will be allowed, at a distance of 21 ft. from the shooting line, supported by PVC pipe inserted in the ground, level with the ground to allow for lawn mowing.
