

Bob P, President, called the meeting to order at 8:15 PM.

The Secretary's reports for the December Annual and Special BOD Meeting were accepted as read, while the report for the February meeting was accepted as amended to show that the Financial Audit is for the Federal Government.

The Treasurer's report for February was tabled.

The Financial Secretary turned in money from memberships consisting of 10 new members, 23 renewals, 8 spousal, 1 junior, 1 life and 3 retired memberships equaling 46 members in February for a total of 321 members with the purchase of 20 indoor range cards. There were 317 members this time last year. A motion was made and carried to file for future audit.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Clay bird – Turned in money for targets, ammo and components. There were 255 member and 10 non-member rounds shot this month. March 8th is the next Winter League match with April 5th being the 100 bird shoot followed by the Banquet.

The Summer Skeet League will start May 13th.

Pistol – The Regional Pistol Match Notices have been turned in to the NRA. The electrical problem with the lights of the first two bays from the left has been fixed. The 2700 Match schedule dates has been submitted.

Rifle - Money was turned in from Matches concluded during the winter. Rifle Competition Match dates have been submitted for the year.

Membership – The orientation process needs to be changed so that orientations are done on the last Sunday of the month by two club members (Henry plus another) with the applications and dues being placed in the safe for Joe, so names may be processed and presented to the Board of Directors for membership acceptance at the following Directors Meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. The sign for the rifle range with the list of rules still needs to be made up and hung.
2. Outdoor pistol targets are still being used for foot mats.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. The following 9 people applied for membership, Gordon M, Michael L, Hakop A, William O, David S, Augusta T, Marcos C, Henry R, Michael K. A motion was made and carried to accept the new members as read.
2. Ted O's classes will be held Mar. 17, 19 and 22.
3. The Range Officer list for 2009 was made available.
4. Ted O's name needs to be added to the Range Officers list.
5. Dave L submitted the Pistol Committee expense report.
6. It is suggested that the bulletin include the notice that no shooting of explosive type targets be shot at the club. Only paper targets should be used .
7. The expansion tank sprung a leak and filled the bulkhead with water which entered the furnace burner. This was fixed and a new sump pump was installed.
8. Bob P asked L.S. Heating and air conditioning to service our furnace for the remainder of the year.

The meeting was adjourned on motion at 9:00 P.M.
